The University of Wolverhampton Science Park is committed to maintaining a Covid-19 informed environment in line with government guidance, ensuring our advice for staff, tenants and visitors remains practical and up to date.

Many of you will have seen that [new Covid-19 rules for staying safe](#) this winter have been introduced. In light of these new guidelines from the Government, we strongly recommend all tenants, staff and visitors who are not exempt, wear a face-covering around the Science Park.

This includes:

- Communal areas, e.g. reception areas, corridors, stairwell and catering outlets.

All Science Park staff are encouraged to take a lateral flow test twice a week and we hope tenants will do so too - kits can be obtained via <https://www.gov.uk/order-coronavirus-rapid-lateral-flow-tests>

To respect the personal safety of every tenant, visitor and member of staff, and ensure we can all help to keep the Science Park a safe place to work (as it has been throughout the pandemic), we ask you and your staff to continue following the guidance documents and keep up to date with current regulations.
