Nigel's Science Park Update 10th December 2021

Dear all,

Many of you will have seen that the [Prime Minister announced that England will be moving to further Plan B measures due to the Omicron variant of Covid-19](#). This includes new guidance on compulsory use of face-coverings, working from home and the introduction of vaccine passports for large events.

We will continue to work within the guidance of the Government and local health protection teams and request all tenants, staff, and visitors, who are not exempt from wearing a face-covering, to do so when on-site at the Science Park.

Please wear a face-covering when you are moving around communal areas, these include:

- Reception areas, corridors, stairwells, and catering outlets.

We endeavour to keep the Science Park a safe place to work (as it has been throughout the pandemic), but we cannot afford to become complacent and must continue to do all we can to reduce the spread of the virus, therefore, we ask you and your staff to continue following the guidance documents and keep up to date with current regulations; recent and upcoming changes can be found on the [Government Website](#)

Your safety and wellbeing are our top priority, all Science Park staff are encouraged to take a lateral flow test twice a week and we hope tenants will do so too - kits can be obtained via <https://www.gov.uk/order-coronavirus-rapid-lateral-flow-tests>
